




How to Manage OmniLogic THEMES

Themes are a method for storing a running configuration of your Omni system for future use. Each theme is a snapshot of the running configuration of the complete Omni system at the time it was created. Themes do not record nor directly affect the water chemistry (chlorination and pH) automation. Water Chemistry automation runs independent of themes.



When you select a Body Of Water (a Pool or Spa) and enter the CONTROLS screen you have the ability to save the Settings from the current running configuration as a Theme.








When creating a new theme you have four (4) things you must define.

1. The Icon used for the theme button
2. Whether the theme is a Favorite
3. The name of the theme
4. Whether the theme is activated with a running Countdown Timer when activated


The favorited themes can be accessed from the Star Button located at the bottom of the Omni mobile app.




The Star button at the bottom of the mobile app screen may be used to access favorited themes along with any favorite features and the **Shutdown**, **Features Off**, and **Help** buttons.




To change the icon to use as a button for a new theme select the Change Icon button, showing the currently selected icon picture and choose an icon from the **Select Icon** screen followed by **Update** button.




A new theme starts with a default selected icon.







To enter the Theme Name:

Select the **Theme Name** edit box which launches the keyboard.




Selecting the **Done** key completes the editing of the theme name.

The **Equipment Settings** associated with the displayed theme are listed at the bottom of the Themes Edit screen. Please note that the equipment settings cannot be changed for the theme.

When equipment is replaced or added new themes are required. The new equipment will not be represented in the existing themes.




A newly added theme has the following defaults:

- No schedule defined
- The new theme is OFF. Toggling this button sets the theme to be either ON and running or OFF.
- Defaults to Favorites List
- No Countdown Timer defined



The *pencil* button, can be selected to edit this theme, which includes setting up schedules and a Countdown Timer that can be set to run the theme for a fixed duration when activated.




When editing a theme you have five (5) things you may modify as well as Delete the theme.

1. The Icon used for the theme button
2. Whether the theme is a Favorite
3. The name of the theme
4. Add or edit schedules.
5. Whether the theme is activated with a running Countdown Timer when activated


Note: The equipment and their individual settings that make up the theme cannot be changed. A new theme is required for any changes in the equipment settings stored for the theme.

The change of the icon selection and editing the name of the theme works the same as it does for when creating a new theme.

Whether to favorite the theme is a toggled On or Off.



Setting a Theme Default Countdown Timer uses pulldown selectors for the hours and minutes.





An **Enabled Countdown Timer** will display a time to start counting down to stop from when the Theme is activated.




A theme's schedule may be added or accessed via the **Schedule** button or the **Menu** button at the bottom of the app.

From the **Menu** the **Schedules** or **Themes** links may be selected.


From the Schedules screen the **Themes** link must be selected.






The **Add New** button at the top right of the Schedules screen and the **Add New Schedule** button both launch the **New Schedule** pop-up,

To add a new schedule for a theme, select the **Theme Schedule** button followed by the **Continue** button to select which theme to setup a new schedule.






The **Schedules** screen can access ALL schedules for individual **Features** and **Themes**.


With **Features** selected you have access to all Feature schedules for Each Body Of Water.

With **Themes** selected you have access to all Theme schedules.



A theme is set to be either **Enabled** and scheduled to run at the set day and time or **Disabled** and not run at the scheduled day and time.

A new schedule can be added for the current Theme by selecting the **Add New Schedule** button.



A Theme Schedule is set to run on selected days at a specific time.



For your convenience buttons are provided for frequently chosen day selections of







Once the day(s) of the week that the Theme schedule is set to run have been selected a Start and End Time needs to set.



Select the **Start Time** and the **End Time** buttons to set a Start and End time for the schedule being configured.

The **Start Time** and **End Time** defaults to 12:00 AM. Selecting the *circle* button on the clock face and sliding it to the time the desired hour, then when done selecting OK will change to selecting the minutes and **OK** then sets the hour and minutes for The **Start Time** and the **End time**, each in turn.







Example of a Theme schedule with **days** selected, **Start** and **End Time** defined.


- Use the **Save** button to save the modifications.
- Use the **Delete** button to delete a schedule.
- Use the **Cancel** button to cancel your current changes.

An active theme can be known to be active by the strip displayed at the top of the app, in this case the Theme is Active due to a schedule.

A new schedule can be added for the displayed Theme by the Add New button in the Schedule screen.





Any theme can be Enabled or Disabled using the toggle button to the right of the listed theme schedule.





The Favorites may be added, deleted or accessed from the **Menu** button at the bottom of the app.

From the **Menu** the **Favorites** links may be selected.



Favorites come in two three types.

System Favorites such as

- System Shutdown
- Features Off
- Help


Favorites that can be toggled ON/Off such as

- Themes
- Light Shows

Favorites that navigate to a feature control screen such as


- Filter Pump
- Heater

Note: System Favorites cannot be edited or deleted.




Creating a new theme based on an existing theme.

1. Start the existing theme, in this example Cool Pool
2. Make settings changes to the features for the new theme
3. Select the Themes menu
4. Select the Add New button
5. Select the icon and new name of the new theme, in this example Hot Pool
6. Select the Save Changes button to save the theme



The new theme, **Hot Pool**, is now available from the themes list .

Note that any changes made creating the new theme are now the system's running settings until manually changed.




When you add or change equipment in your configuration you will see this warning when saving your new Omni configuration.



Instructions for replacing the existing theme with the new equipment follows on the next page.

Note the new Pool feature named **Pool Light2**.







Equipment Settings for the theme **Cool Pool** does not contain the newly added equipment **Pool Light2**. . When run, this theme will not change the state of **Pool Light2**.


The **Equipment Settings** cannot be edited but a new theme can be created using the existing theme. To create a new theme based on the old one.




1. Edit the existing theme and change the name. For example, prefix with "old".
2. Run the "old" Theme
3. Set the new feature/equipment to a desired setting.
4. Create a new theme with the same name and icon as the original theme .
5. Delete the original "old" theme.



The Equipment Settings for the newly created theme **Cool Pool** now includes **Pool Light2** with a setting of *Royal Blue*.

Now that you now have the new version of the Cool Pool theme you need to remove the old renamed version of the Cool Pool theme.





Edit the **oldCool Pool** theme and select the **Delete Theme** button. Confirm the **Delete** of the theme..
