2021 DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY (DOE) REGULATORY CHANGES

- The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) regulatory changes for dedicated-purpose pool pumps (DPPP) affect what can be manufactured after July 19, 2021.
 - » This is a DOE-driven initiative EVERY manufacturer is required to comply with
 - » The purpose is to meet new legislative energy-efficiency standards
- **2.** Affects SOME (not all) in-ground high efficiency pumps.
 - » Important: All Hayward Super Pump[®] and MaxFlo[®] XL high efficiency pumps 1 HP and lower meet the new DOE energy-efficiency standards
 - » High efficiency pump options:
 - » All 1 HP and lower MaxFlo XL models are fully compliant
 - » All 1 HP and lower Super Pumps the world's best-selling high efficiency pumps—are fully compliant and will continue to be manufactured
 - » Ultra-high efficiency pump options:
 - » Hayward VS and XE pumps are the most energy-efficient on the market as measured by the new DOE weighted energy factor (WEF) standards, boasting the industry's highest WEF per published ENERGY STAR[®] data*.

- » Non-compliant pumps can no longer be *manufactured* as of July 19, 2021
- » After July 19, 2021, dealers can still buy the older pumps and install them, as long as they can find available inventory
- » Customers do not have to return product—and they won't want to, because the non-compliant models will likely be in high demand from dealers who like their performance and relatively low cost
- **4.** Most above-ground products are compliant, although their associated horsepower ratings may change.
